## **VALUE BURGUNDY BY THE GLASS**

Customers have been asking us for more red Burgundies by the glass. So here they are!

My team and I tasted a selection of almost 50 red Burgundies this month and curated a list of 20 of the best wines.

The vintages in this list – mostly 2017, 2018 and 2019 – have vibrant fruit character and are great for early drinking.

We found that now, with increasingly warm vintages in general, excellent value can be found from the Hautes Côtes de Nuits – the hillsides of Burgundy – as well as lesser known villages like Marsannay in the north. And of course there are some gems from the classic villages of Gevrey Chambertin, Morey St Denis and Nuits St Georges. Some beautiful wines are also from the Côte de Beaune. Plus, look out for a couple of reds from Chassagne- Montrachet – better known for its chardonnay, the reds have fantastic tannin structure and focus.

We believe that good Burgundy should not be determined by exclusivity and sky-high prices, but more on delicious, good value wines. And now is a great time to discover value red Burgundy. Please drink and enjoy.

So delicious and impressive now, but even better in 2023.	93	130	
Bachelet-Monnot Maranges 1er Cru Clos de La Boutière 2018 Plums, dark cherries, tobacco and tea leaves on the nose. Together with dark-chocolate and some savory-meat notes. It's medium-bodied with tight-grained tannins. Serious and austere mineral expression. Crystal clear. Try from 2022, but already so good to drink.	92	130	
Domaine Pierre Boisson Monthélie 2017  Aromas of raspberries, cassis and mocha. It's medium-bodied with fine tannins and fresh acidity. Rich and creamy with a velvety texture. Long, supple finish. Classy. Refined. Drink now or hold.	94	140	
Bouchard Père & Fils Nuits-Saint-Georges 2016  Aromas of ripe strawberries and fresh flowers follow through to a full body with round tannins and a bright feel. Some earth and stone undertones. Delicious now. Why wait?	93	145	
Bouchard Père & Fils Gevrey-Chambertin 2016 A perfumed nose of redcurrants, sour cherries, dried herbs, mushrooms and baking spices. Medium-to full- bodied with chalky tannins and bright acidity. Domaine Bertrand Bachelet Maranges 2018 Wonderful aromas of blackberries and cherries with hints of smoke and bark, as well as cedar.
