It's an extension of all the Great Wines events I organize around the world including in Hong Kong, Beijing, Shanghai, Seoul, Bangkok, New York, San Francisco, Miami, Dallas, Chicago and Los Angeles. It takes JamesSuckling.com offline and brings to life my travels across the winegrowing world with my team of tasters, showcasing just a select few of the more than 20,000 wines we rate and hundreds of wineries we visit each year.

James Suckling Wine Central is a place to share an outstanding glass of wine, whether a prized rare bottle or an affordable, unusual find. It's a place where the wine novice should feel as comfortable as the wine connoisseur, because drinking wine is fun and doesn't have to be pretentious or nerve-wracking. And you can always count on the quality of the wines here as only those we scored 90 points or more are selected for the list.

For me, this wine bar is the embodiment of my career as a wine critic for the past four decades. It's a physical extension of my experience and love for writing, reviewing and drinking hundreds of thousands of wines, and it's the dream of my dear wife, Marie, who left her native Korea to work as a wine merchant for 15 years in London and Hong Kong before joining me in my endeavors.

We always wanted to do a wine bar with food we like to eat: straightforward and delicious with touches of Korean cuisine that my wife ate growing up in Seoul. Marie created the small menu with our chef. The sommeliers and waiters travel and taste with me so they know most of the wines and my personal tastes. Most of the wines offered by the glass or bottle are from wineries that attend JamesSuckling.com wine events. The special sections such as "James' Cellar Selection" and "Wines of My Career (100-point wines)" are personal favorites — wines I revere and love to drink. You'll notice a heavy emphasis on Italy, Bordeaux and Port. I am sorry I didn't buy, rate and drink more Burgundy! But I didn't.

Marie and I hope you enjoy the wines on the list with hundreds available by the glass thanks to the Coravin preservation system. Enjoy my Lalique glasses too; I designed them myself with France's famous crystal maker. 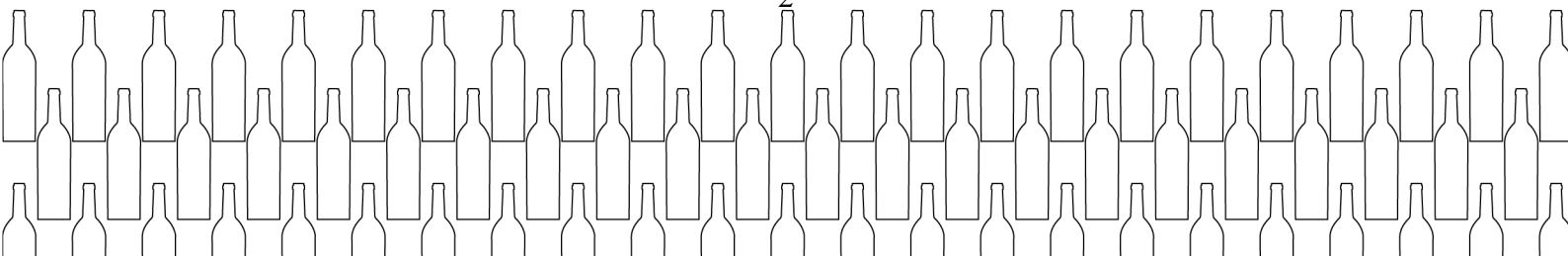

### Louis Roederer Champagne Collection 242 Brut NV *Champagne*

94 175

Aromas of cooked apple, bread dough and lemon tart follow through to a full body with round, delicious fruit and a rich, flavorful finish. Yet, it remains tight and fine with lovely, compressed bubbles. New energy and freshness. Medium-to full-bodied with layers of fruit and vivid intensity. 42% chardonnay, 36% pinot noir and 22% pinot meunier. 8 grams dosage. Four years on the lees. A new-format non-vintage that designates the year of the 242nd harvest, 2017, plus reserve wine of 2009, 2011, 2013, 2014, 2015 and 2016. Drink or hold.

### Taittinger Champagne Comtes de Champagne Blanc de Blancs 2008 *Champagne*

100 380

The perfect blanc de blancs. Full-bodied with a lovely framework of acidity and dry fruit, such as apples, pears and peaches. Opulent. Dense and muscular. Yet, it's balanced and harmonious. Line of acidity at the end. Totally in tune. Superb. Deep and complete. Has everything. One for the cellar. It is the greatest Comte ever. It has everything. A perfect upgrade from two years ago. Drink or hold.

## WHITE

### Arboleda Chardonnay Aconcagua Costa 2021 *Chile*

94 70

A fresh, cool and flavorful chardonnay, showing chalky green fruit, stones, guava, sliced green apples and subtle, fine lees and sour cream. This is a fresh, medium-to full-bodied and ample expression of the variety, with impressive substance on the center-palate, yet rendered in a very nimble and elegant way. A fine and cooler expression of chardonnay from Chile with some subtle creaminess in the end. Delicious now, so why wait? Screw cap.

### Clos d'Agon Cataluña Blanco 2017 *Spain*

91 110

A slightly reduced nose with white-almond perfume and a gently grassy edge. The palate is dry, crisp and has attractive, pastry-like texture and smooth build at the finish. Drink now.

### Domaine Raymond Duport-Fahn Bourgogne Aligoté 2018 *France*

92 115

This is really typical for this grape with peaches and limes and slightly green character. Medium body. Bright, lively finish. Delicious now.

### Cantina Terlan Pinot Bianco Alto Adige Vorberg Riserva 2007 (Magnum) *Italy*

97 210

This is showing so well for a white wine with 14 years of age, showing the real character of pinot bianco from Vorberg. Complex aromas of dried flowers, apricots, pineapples, lemons, crushed stones, flint, blanched almonds and hints of cardamom. It's full-bodied with an incredible texture, almost oily, yet still so fresh with bright acidity. Long. Drink now.

### Mullineux Chenin Blanc Swartland Granite 2018 *South Africa*

95 210

A fabulous white, showing mango, papaya and dried-lemon character with stony and floral notes. Hints of dried orange and spice. It's full-bodied, yet agile and beautiful on the finish. One of the best whites from South Africa and from chenin blanc! From biodynamically grown grapes. Drink now.

### Frescobaldi Toscana Gorgona 2017 *Italy*

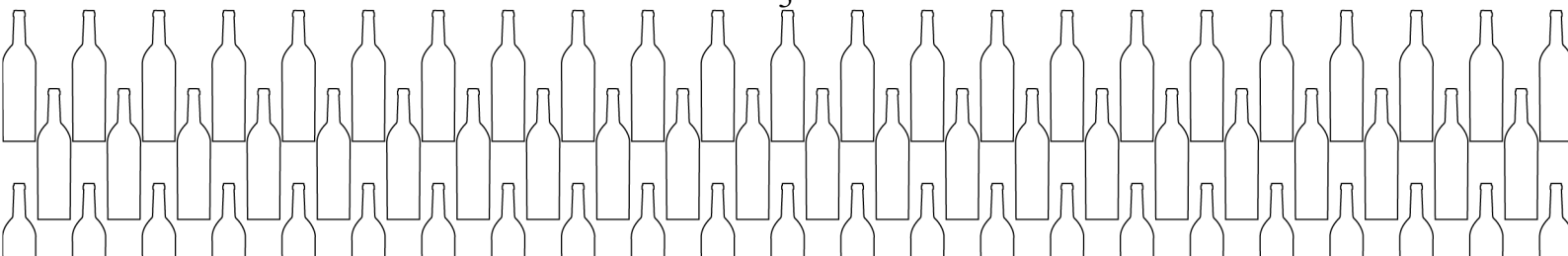

The palate shows great vitality and focus, driven along by well-balanced acidity. Medium-to full-bodied, oily and textured, but so taut and fine. Long, polished finish. Drink now.

### Peter Michael Sonoma County Knights Valley L'Apres-Midi 2019 *California*

97 270

Aromas of green mango, cooked pear, lemon curd and quince. Lemon wax, flint and toasted almonds, too. It's full-bodied with a creamy, oily texture. Dense and phenolic with fantastic concentration. Yet, it remains agile and always so balanced and focused. 90% sauvignon blanc and 10% semillon. Drink or hold.

<b>Château Giscours Bordeaux Le Rosé de Giscours 2020</b> <i>France</i>	92	90

A very pretty rosé with strawberry, currant and orange-peel aromas and flavors. It's full-bodied with lots of fruit and a savory and fruity finish. Nice phenolics to it. Layered. A little bit more there than the 2019. Pure cabernet sauvignon. Really delicious. Drink now.

<b>Château d'Esclans Côtes de Provence Whispering Angel Rosé 2021</b> <i>France</i>	92	110
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Pale rose color with pretty aromas of lavender, rosehip, strawberries, cherries and cloves. It's medium-bodied with crisp acidity and a supple, creamy palate. Perfumed and elegant. Drink now.

Happy for you to try my crazy global blend I made in 2009 from reds from France, USA and Mexico. It's mostly Rhone varieties such as syrah and grenache with a bit of merlot and zinfandel. Fun. Cheap. And satisfying. A Pope even drank it in Italy! So it can't be bad.

<b>Marcelo Pelleriti Valle de Uco Selection Blend of Terroir 2016</b> <i>Argentina</i>	94	140
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A firm, precise red with blackberries and olives. Floral undertones. Medium body and silky tannins that caress your palate. Shows length and finesse. Focused and pretty. Delicious now, but better after 2022

<b>Château Thivin Côte-de-Brouilly Cuvée Zaccharie 2019</b> <i>France</i>	96	160
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Time seems to stop when you smell the ravishing violets and summer flowers offered by this great Côte de Brouilly. Breathtaking harmony and finesse, the power totally underplayed, in spite of the substantial fine tannins that anchor this wine. Super long, spicy and mineral finish. Great aging potential. Drink or hold.

<b>Cantina Terlan Lagrein Alto Adige Porphyris Riserva 2016</b> <i>Italy</i>	96	195
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You rarely, if ever, see this level of complexity in a lagrein, which goes headlong through bracken, tea leaves, vanilla, blackberries, undergrowth, heather and violet extract. Full-bodied and very structured indeed, the chewy tannins envelop layers of compact yet exuberant dark fruit. Elements of undergrowth and spice linger on the long finish. Stunning. Delicious now, but better in 2022.

<b>Emiliana Valle de Colchagua Los Robles Estate Gê 2015</b> <i>Chile</i>	93	180
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Extremely perfumed and bright with dark berry, wet earth and spice character. Full body, silky and polished with beautiful fruit and character. Long and intense. Layered. A blend of syrah, carmenere, cabernet sauvignon, garnacha, malbec and mourvedre. Biodynamically grown grapes. Drink or hold.

<b>Mayer Syrah Yarra Valley 2019</b> <i>Australia</i>	94	230
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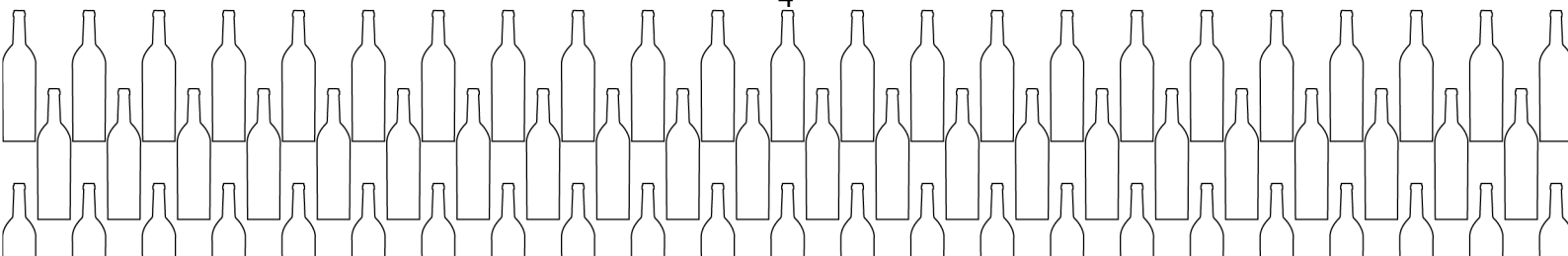
Subtle aromas of blackberry, gun metal, cloves and white pepper follow through to a medium body with round, creamy tannins that are polished and beautiful. Firm and lively with a flavorful finish. Drink or hold.

<b>Errázuriz Pinot Noir Aconcagua Costa Las Pizarras 2018</b> <i>Chile</i>	99	220
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Great aromas of dried strawberries and fresh flowers, such as lavender. Full-bodied yet very tight and focused. Impressive tannic structure, but refined and polished. Lightly chewy. Finishes tight and refined. Best pinot of Chile. Drink after 2022, but hard to hold back.

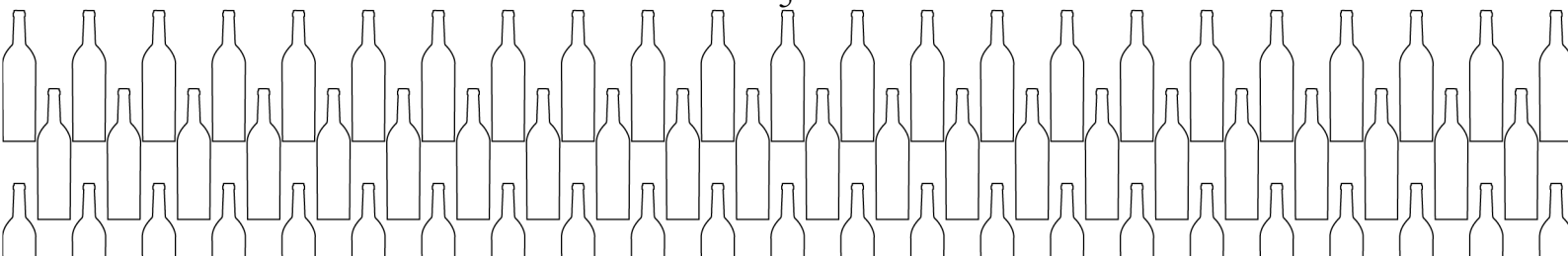
<b>Benanti Etna Rosso Rovitello Particella No. 341 Alberello Centenario Riserva 2015</b> <i>Italy</i>	98	280
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A whole garden of summer flowers pour from the glass, together with hints of cola nut and wild strawberry. A phenomenally concentrated Etna red with stunningly fine tannins that give this a structure that's as big as Mount Etna itself. So much power at the finish, yet this remains very precise and graceful. Made from over 100-year-old pre-phyloxera nerello mascalese and nerello cappuccio vines. It was 24 months in French oak, but that's almost completely invisible. Limited quantity. Drink or hold.



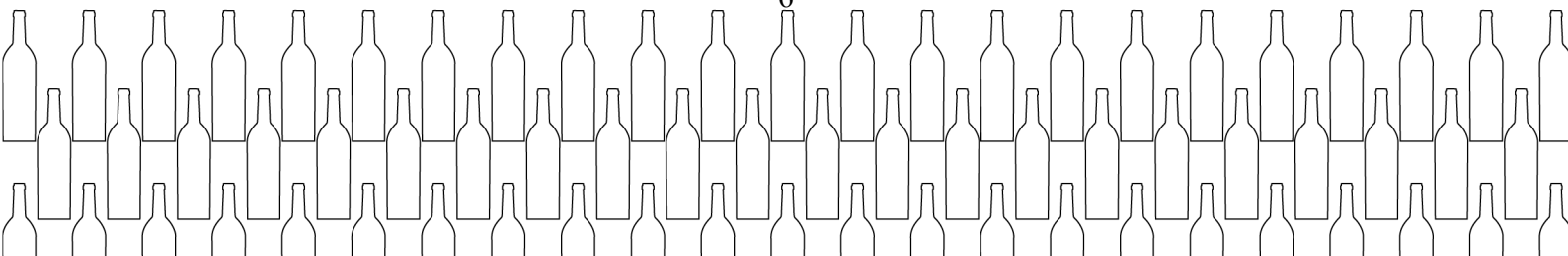

The palate drops mouth-filling flavors of peach and lemon and winds tight, before exploding long on the finish with a long, nutty afterglow. Perfect chardonnay. Drink over the next decade or more. <p><b>2 Barone Ricasoli Chianti Classico Gran Selezione Ceniprimo 2018</b> <i>Italy</i></p> <p>This is amazing Chianti Classico. Perhaps the greatest I have ever tasted. The aromas are so complex with crushed cherries, sour cherries, peaches, bark and hints of meat. Incredible finish with such intensity and beauty. Hard not to drink, but one for the cellar. <p><b>4 Mount Mary Yarra Valley Quintet 2019</b> <i>Australia</i></p> <p>This is a great Quintet, one of the best in fact. Here's a wine that combines such elegance, power and polish to a level seen in the best wines of Bordeaux in the best vintages. Aromas of blueberries, cassis and mulberries are framed in cedar and fresh, leafy cabernet tones, as well as violets and forest wood. Some subtle oak spice here, too. The palate is so seamlessly layered with ultra-fine tannins that carry pristine blueberry, redcurrant and blackcurrant flavors. Concentrated, with pitch-perfect balance. <p><b>7 Taittinger Champagne Comtes de Champagne Blanc de Blancs 2008</b> <i>France</i></p> <p>The perfect blanc de blancs. <p><b>Château Canon St.-Emilion 2015</b> <i>Wine of the Year 2018</i></p> <p>Seductive. The nose draws you in deep: it's like staring into a well of pristine dark cherries, dark plums, blackberries and mulberries. All the oak is perfectly subsumed. The palate's flawless with immense depth and power and it's so balanced as to appear to float. Immaculate fresh dark-berry and plum flavors. Silky and deep, ribbon-like finish. Perfect. Aromas and flavors of dried strawberry, iodine, oyster shell, wet earth, fresh mushrooms and flowers. Full-bodied, tight and focused with chewy tannins and a long, extensive mouth feel. <b>2 Livio Sassetti Brunello di Montalcino 2016</b> <i>Italy</i> Blackberries, black walnuts and black cherries, as well as loads of chewy tannins. Some smoked wood, wood tannins and even black truffles. It's full-bodied and powerful with loads going on. It just keeps growing on the palate. <b>6 Wittmann Riesling Rheinhessen Morstein GG 2019</b> <i>Germany</i> Let go of the narrow human world and fall into this expansive dry riesling that busts out of the conventional framework for the grape variety. And that's what makes it so difficult to describe. However, there is certainly more yellow fruit (mirabelle, but also a hint of pineapple) than white (some ripe pear) and the minerality is huge, yet totally precise and delicate. The finish really doesn't want to stop! From biodynamically grown grapes with Respekt certification. Drink or hold.	100	350	1750
<b>7 Dönnhoff Riesling Nahe Dellchen GG 2019</b> <i>Germany</i> Ravishing bouquet of a thousand golden fruits and a staggering interplay of diamond-bright acidity and great succulence. Then, just when you think you've processed all that, along comes a monster wave of minerality, which sweeps you off your feet. But you land on the beach, deliriously happy. From organically grown grapes with Fair'n Green certification. Drink or hold.	100	325	1625
<b>8 Tassi Brunello di Montalcino Franci Riserva 2015</b> <i>Italy</i> An amazingly solid and powerful red with so much depth and intensity. Dark berries, cherries, walnuts and coffee on the nose and palate with some grilled meat. It's full-bodied with a very powerful palate of chewy, polished tannins and great length and intensity. Goes on for minutes. Better after 2025.	100	395	1975
<b>9 Cheval des Andes Mendoza 2017</b> <i>Argentina</i> This is the greatest Cheval des Andes ever. Discrete aromas of blackberries, flowers, stone and licorice. So perfumed. The integration of fruit, tannins and acidity is fantastic. Full-bodied, tight and solid with beautiful depth and integrity. Extremely long and exciting. Complex and compelling with such refinement and length. A blend of 62% malbec and 38% cabernet sauvignon. Available in September 2020. Better after 2024.	100	310	1550
<b>10 Clos Apalta Valle de Apalta 2017</b> <i>Chile</i> What a stunning nose of crushed berries, fresh flowers, sandalwood and light vineyard dust. Black olives, too. Very complex. Full-bodied with a beautiful, dense palate of blackberries, chocolate, walnuts and cigar box. Fantastic length and composure. The tannin just rolls over the palate. Very structured. The most classically structured wine ever from here. Goes on for minutes. Outrageous and so polished. A blend of 48% carmenere, 26% cabernet sauvignon, 25% merlot and 1% petit verdot. A complex nose of blackberry, plum, mocha, cigar box, graphite and spice. It's full-bodied with fine tannins. Creamy-textured and structured with a juicy core. Pure with a velvety texture on the palate, which is layered and balanced and leads to a flavorful finish that lasts over and over. Spicy on the finish with cloves and black pepper. Grilled meat, too. A blend of 52% syrah, 34% carmenere and 14% cabernet sauvignon. From biodynamically grown grapes. Vegan. Try in 2023.

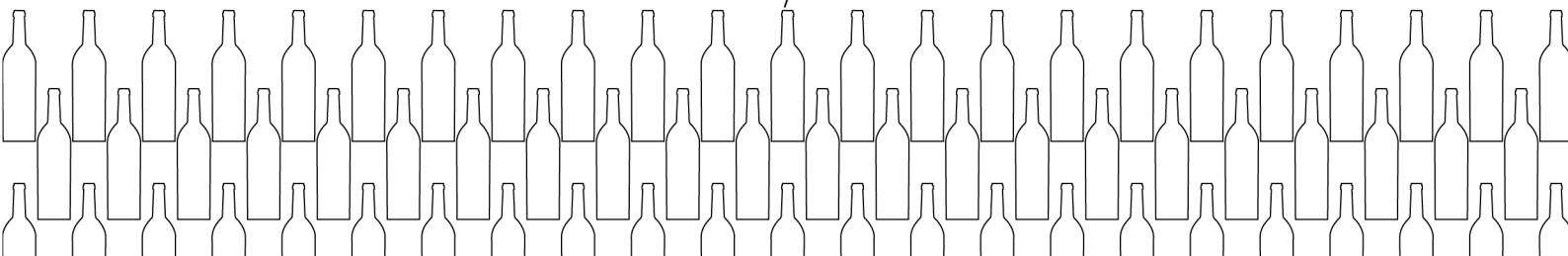

## CHINA

**Ao Yun Shangri-la 敖云云南香格里拉 2016 Red** **96** 480 2400  
A Very pure red with currants, blackberries and fresh leaves. Mushrooms and wet earth. Some tobacco. Cigars. Charcoal. Medium-to Full-bodied with fine, silky tannins and an intense, flavourful finish. It grows on the palate with chewy yet polished tannins Delicious. Turns to currants. Needs two or three years to soften. The greatest Chinese wine to date. Better after 2023

## FRANCE

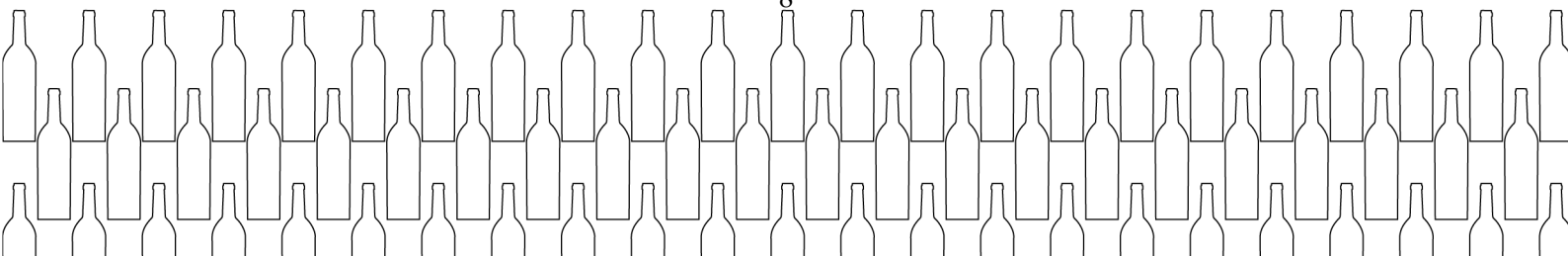
**Domaine Weinbach Riesling Alsace Grand Cru Schlossberg Cuvée Ste. Catherine 2018 - Off Dry White** **99** 350 1750  
One of the wines of this challenging vintage in Alsace, this is a masterpiece of concentrated minerality, but also has a seductive, kaleidoscopic array of yellow and exotic-fruit aromas (most obviously puréed peach). Tons of structure, but this is already so beautifully interwoven into the palate that it simply adds textural complexity at the very long finish. From the estate's oldest vines on the granitic Grand Cru Schlossberg. From biodynamically grown grapes. Drink or hold.

## ITALY

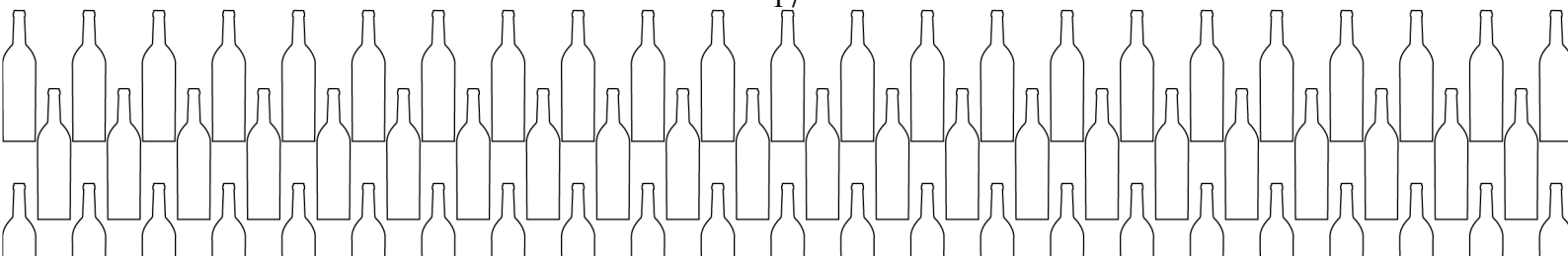
# VALUE BURGUNDY BY THE GLASS

Customers have been asking us for more red Burgundies by the glass. So here they are!

My team and I tasted a selection of almost 50 red Burgundies this month and curated a list of 20 of the best wines. The vintages in this list – mostly 2017, 2018 and 2019 – have vibrant fruit character and are great for early drinking. We found that now, with increasingly warm vintages in general, excellent value can be found from the Hautes Côtes de Nuits – the hillsides of Burgundy – as well as lesser known villages like Marsannay in the north. And of course there are some gems from the classic villages of Gevrey Chambertin, Morey St Denis and Nuits St Georges. Some beautiful wines are also from the Côte de Beaune. Plus, look out for a couple of reds from Chassagne- Montrachet – better known for its chardonnay, the reds have fantastic tannin structure and focus.

We believe that good Burgundy should not be determined by exclusivity and sky-high prices, but more on delicious, good value wines. And now is a great time to discover value red Burgundy. Please drink and enjoy.

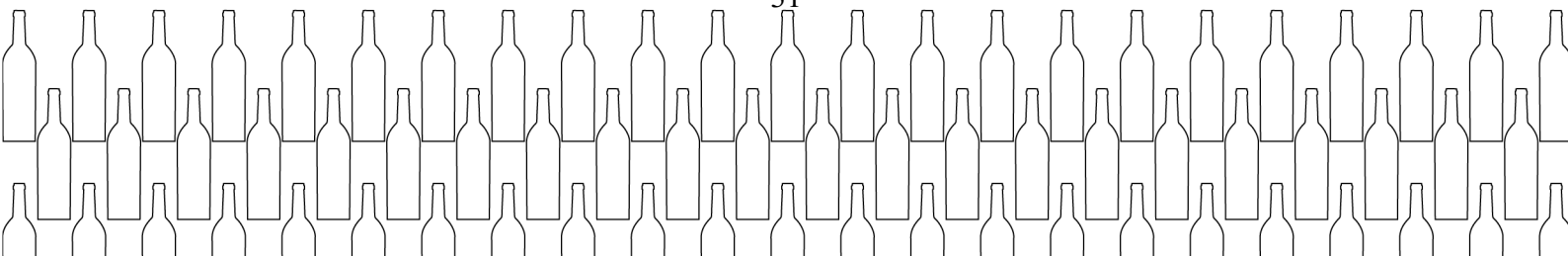


# SUPER TUSCAN SELECTION

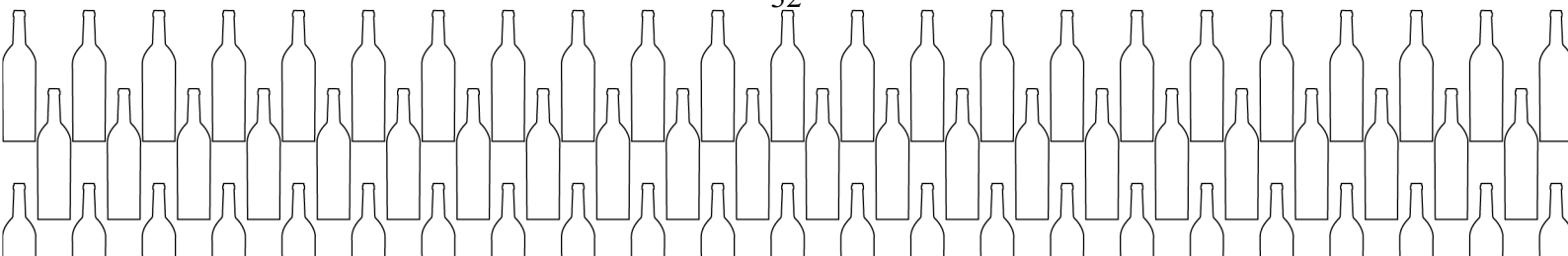
Some say that James created the phrase “Super Tuscan” but he doesn’t take credit for it. It was probably his friend American wine writer Burton Anderson who used to live down the road from James in Tuscany. In any case, the term was created in the 1980s to describe wines that were outside of traditional appellations such as

Chianti Classico or Bolgheri but extremely high quality. It could be anything from a Bordeaux blend to pure Sangiovese. The popularity of Super Tuscans continues although some wines, such as Sassicaia, are now part of an official appellation.
