James Suckling Wine Central is a place to share an outstanding glass of wine, whether a prized rare bottle or an affordable, unusual find. It's a place where the wine novice should feel as comfortable as the wine connoisseur, because drinking wine is fun and doesn't have to be pretentious or nerve-wracking. And you can always count on the quality of the wines here as only those we scored 90 points or more are selected for the list.



You'll notice a heavy emphasis on Italy, Bordeaux and Port. I am sorry I didn't buy, rate and drink more Burgundy! But I didn't.

Marie and I hope you enjoy the wines on the list with hundreds available by the glass thanks to the Coravin preservation system. Enjoy my Lalique glasses too; I designed them myself with France's famous crystal maker. Mazzei Toscana Siepi 2016

What a beautiful nose of elderberries, freshly picked blackcurrants, citrus, herbs, licorice and crushed stones, amidst a backdrop of coffee beans, cedar and vanilla. Full-bodied and very subtle and refined with tightly wound tannins and an impressive balance of fruit and acidity. Long, grainy and elegant on the finish. A masterpiece. Drink in 2020.

SPARKLING

Follador Prosecco di Valdobbiadene Superiore Cuvée Torri di Credazzo Millesimato Extra Dry 2018

92 90

The nose is really all about the citrus and green-fruit aromas that range from lemons and limes to green apples and fresh herbs. Nicely textured and refined, the spicy green apples wrapping around taut acidity. Drink now.

Jacquesson Champagne Cuvée No. 742 Extra-Brut NV

93 170

What would life be without Champagne? One word. Miserable. Start with a glass! Or two.

WHITE

Bodega Garzón Albariño Garzón Reserva 2019

92 90

Plenty of sliced apple and pear aromas with some white peaches on the nose. Medium body, crisp and bright acidity and a delicious, clean finish. Drink now.

Adelina Arneis Adelaide Hills Eternal Return 2018

92 90

A mix of fresh and dried pears, lemons and gently biscuity, savory notes here, as well as meadow flowers. The palate has a refined, sleek and crisp feel with fresh fruit in abundance. Drink now. Screw cap.

Howard's Folly Vinho Regional Alentejano Sonhador 2018

93 120

This is a surprising white with freshness and tanginess, as well as exotic fruit. It's full-bodied with bright acidity and a lively, vivid finish. Lots of lemon rind, green papaya and mango. Creamy texture. Drink and enjoy.

Frankland Estate Riesling Frankland River Isolation Ridge 2017



The array of fresh and mouthwatering citrus fruit is stunning, and it includes grapefruit, mandarin oranges, lime and kumquat. The palate is both powerful and concentrated. It delivers deep citrus flavors in a convincing style. Drink or hold.

Trapiche Chardonnay Mendoza Gran Medalla 2016

94 150

This is a special chardonnay with stones, mangoes and apples and lemons. Full-bodied yet so



tight and intense with salt and mineral undertones. Some chalk, too. Made in large casks. Drink now.

ROSÉ

Château Giscours Bordeaux Le Rosé de Giscours 2019

92 90

This pure cabernet sauvignon shows very pretty peaches, cherries and stones, even crushed cement. Medium body with some phenolic tension and a lightly austere and fresh finish. Probably the best rosé in Bordeaux.

Château d'Esclans Côtes de Provence Rock Angel 2017 France

92 110

This is my go-to rosé that remains crisp and bright with all the energy and attraction of France's best blush wines. A standard for the coolest beach clubs on the Côte d'Azur.

RED

Chacra Pinot Noir Patagonia Barda 2018

94 100

A brambly array of bright, ripe dark fruit with a lithe and juicy feel that carries a bold, deliciously fresh array of dark-cherry and blueberry flavors long on the finish. Zingy and energetic. 10 to 15 per cent stems in fermentation. From biodynamically grown grapes. Drink or hold.

One Wine One World Valle de Guadelupe

\$8 from each glass goes to Eco Drive to reduce single-use plastic in Hong Kong

Happy for you to try my crazy global blend I made in 2009 from reds from France, USA and Mexico. It's mostly Rhone varieties such as syrah and grenache with a bit of merlot and zinfandel. Fun. Cheap. And satisfying. A Pope even drank it in Italy! So it can't be bad.

Muga Rioja Reserva 2015

94 125

Complex nose with ripe black cherries, deeply integrated cedar oak, baking spices, dried flowers, leather, fresh tobacco and earthy notes. This is silky and mellow with long, laid-back tannins that deliver ripe dark plum flavors into a spicy and earthy finish. Drink or hold.

Ochota Barrels Pinot Meunier Adelaide Hills Marc of Cain 2019

92 160

Wild strawberries and raspberries with a gentle, floral edge. The palate has a smooth, fine and quite full feel with vibrant acidity and paper-fine, fresh tannins. Crunchy red fruit. Drink now.

Pio Cesare Barolo 2014

94 160

Bright and complex with licorice, tar and rose petals. Hints of plums, too. Medium to full body and chewy, round tannins. Plenty of dried meat, spices and berries. A pretty finish. Shows intensity for the vintage. Already very pretty but drink in 2020.

Marchesi Antinori Toscana Tignanello 2016



Wonderful aromas of pine needles, rosemary, fresh mushrooms, bark and dark fruit. Full body. Very tight and tannic backbone. Racy and driven. Undertones of orange peel and wet earth. Even licorice and mint. Great finish. Better after 2021, but exciting to taste now.

Realm Cellars Napa Valley The Bard 2014


The aromas of oysters and peaches combine beautifully with the blackberry and blackcurrant character. Black olives, too. Full-bodied, layered and very intense with chocolate, black fruit and an intense, savory finish. Best Bard ever. Try in 2020, but already so pretty.





1	Siro Pacenti Brunello di Montalcino Vecchie Vigne 2015 <i>Wine of the Year 2019</i> This is very intense on the nose with blue fruit, cool stones, brambleberries and blackberries. Wet earth, too. Full-bodied and extremely dense and powerful with a super center palate of fruit and ripe yet compact tannins. Lightly chewy and expressive. Superb transparency and integration. Goes on for minutes. One of the best Brunellos I have tasted in my career. Try after 2021, but already amazing.	100	255	1530
2	Renieri Brunello di Montalcino 2015 Earthy aromas of bark, sand, truffles, graphite, rust, terracotta and sandalwood rise up from the deep with Burgundian poise; fruitier orange zest and preserved lemons glimmer in their wake, while riper incense and tar lurk in this dense forest of aromas. Physics itself gives way as the line between reduction and oxidation is blurred. There's such richness to the center palate, but the fruit there is vivacious and elegant, swaddled in robust but generous tannins that breach the outermost reaches of the mouth. The finish is hauntingly long, the after effects of the acidity unworldly. This is certainly in a quiet, reserved stage of evolution, and will need time to fully mature in bottle. 3	Muga Rioja Prado Enea Gran Reserva 2011 The most structured Prado Enea ever. A reduced center palate that is so compact with dark fruit, dark mushrooms and cedar spice. Full body. Wonderfully polished tannins and a long, long finish. Electric acidity. Muscular and well toned. This is a new classic that reminds me of great Spanish wines from the 1940s and 1950s. Better after 2021, but already so impressive.	99	225	1350
4	Marchesi Antinori Umbria Cervaro Della Sala 2017 This is big and powerful, without being ripe and heavy. So much apple, stone, and hints of toffee. Aromatic. Full-bodied, layered and framed with phenolic tension and a great finish. Muscular and agile at the same time. One of the best I have tasted. Drink or hold.	99	220	1170
5	Schäfer-Fröhlich Riesling Nahe Felseneck GG 2018 Very pure slate here, this is something unique. The elevated, steep and stony site has such strength of character, delivered with such purity. Gun smoke, gunflint and very fine fragrance with a streak of fresh lemons. So fine. The palate has a super fine and elegant feel, floating ballet-like over the palate. Such elegance and power. The finesse and length is really ethereal. Yellow-grapefruit juice and pith here. Wildly succulent at the long, salty finish. What a thrilling wine. Drink or hold.	99	160	960
6	Rippon Pinot Noir Central Otago Mature Vine 2010 This has such freshness at between nine and ten years of age. It delivers a very rich, blue-fruit core with spiced earth and light, leathery nuances. The palate has composed and compact tannins and a slinky and rich, powerful array of blueberries and a long, juicy, succulent and vibrant finish. Shows just how well Rippon pinots age. This is just getting started! From biodynamically grown grapes. Maturation release. Drink or hold.	100		1600
7	Château Larcis Ducasse St.-Emilion 2016 The aromas here are so spellbinding with shiitake mushrooms, wet earth and moss, as well as tree bark and, finally, dark fruit. The palate is incredible as it builds and grows with full body, but always tight and reserved. It shows so much depth and complexity. Please try not to touch this until 2025.	99	260	1560



8	Eredi Fuligni Brunello di Montalcino 2015	The purity of fruit on the nose is perfection with cherries, crushed raspberries, mineral, pumice and citrus fruit. Dust, too. Full body. Powerful, chewy tannins. So long and muscular, yet polished and formed. Most structured Brunello I have ever had from here. A wine for decades. Try after 2022.	100	245	1470
9	Errázuriz Pinot Noir Aconcagua Costa Las Pizarras 2018	Great aromas of dried strawberries and fresh flowers, such as lavender. Full-bodied yet very tight and focused. Impressive tannic structure, but refined and polished. Lightly chewy. Finishes tight and refined. Best pinot of Chile. Drink after 2022, but hard to hold back.	99	220	1150
10	Cheval des Andes Mendoza 2016	Super refined and beautiful with flowers, spices, dried fruit and hints of stones. Medium to full body with very fine tannins and a gorgeous finish. Shows great finesse and depth. Savory character, as always, but in check. Drink in 2022.	99	210	1250
Almaviva Puente Alto 2015 Wine of the Year 2017			100	510	2330
A glorious and complex nose of tobacco, blackberries and hints of stones and flowers. Hints of bitter chocolate. Full-bodied, very tight and compacted. Linear backbone gives this form and tension. It has the same character on the palate as well as cayenne and other spice. Loved the 2014 but this shows more fine-grained tannins. So balanced and harmonious. A blend of 69% cabernet sauvignon, 24% carmenere, 5% cabernet franc and 2% petit verdot. Needs four or five years in bottle but a joy to taste now.

Seductive. The nose draws you in deep: It's like staring into a well of pristine dark cherries, dark plums, blackberries and mulberries. All the oak is perfectly subsumed. The palate's flawless with immense depth and power and it's so balanced as to appear to float. Immaculate fresh dark-berry and plum flavors. Silky and deep, ribbon-like finish. Perfect. Best from 2022.

PARTICIPATING WINERIES ALSO SEND A SELECTION OF BOTTLED WINES THAT THEY WANT GUESTS TO TRY. HERE'S THE LIST. IT FOCUSES ON THREE EXCELLENT YEARS – 2016, 2015 AND 2014 – AS WELL AS THE VERY GOOD 2017. THE WINES ARE YOUNG BUT SHOW WHAT I CALL THE 'NEW CLASSICISM' OF BORDEAUX. ALL WINES ARE PRICED AROUND RETAIL PRICE UNTIL STOCKS LAST.
