Laurent-Perrier Champagne Grand Siècle N.26 NV (France) (Wine of Year 2023)

Magical blend of three vintages including the legendary 2008. Best Champagne ever?

BV Napa Valley Georges de Latour PR 2019 (California) (Wine of Year 2022)

Beaulieu Vineyard has made some of the greatest Napa Cabs ever. Here's another one.

Château Canon St.-Emilion 2015 (France) (Wine of Year 2018)

Canon 2015 is a modern legend and reminds James of the great 1955.

Almaviva Puente Alto 2015 (Chile) (Wine of Year 2017)

This Bordeaux blend from Chile sets the standard for the best wines in South America.

OTHER 100 POINTS

Wittmann Riesling Rheinhessen Morstein GG 2019 (Germany)

This cru riesling is dry and vivid with lots of body and power. Great GG.

Catena Zapata Chardonnay Mendoza Adrianna Vineyard White Bones 2018 (Argentina)

This rich chardonnay competes with the best grand cru of Burgundy.

Mount Mary Yarra Valley Quintet 2019 (Australia) (No.4 Wine of the Year 2021)

The balance, structure, and finesse of this Bordeaux blend mind-boggles.

Château Beauséjour Duffau-Lagarrosse St.-Emilion 2015 (France)

Everyone still talks about the greatness of the 1990 form here but this is better!

FRESH AND CRISP

Champagne

Louis Roederer Champagne Collection 243 Brut NV Champagne (France)

Probably the best NV entry-level Champagne and from organically grown vineyards.

White

Arboleda Chardonnay Aconcagua Costa 2021 (Chile)

Cool climate chard with influence from the Pacific with fresh and clean character.

Ata Rangī Sauvignon Blanc Martinborough Te Wa 2019 (New Zealand)

This producer is one of the best pinot noir makers, but its SB is equally terrific quality.

Nals Margreid Pinot Bianco Alto Adige Sirmian 2021 (Italy)

You can taste the mineral character in this excellent mountain white.

Feudo Maccari Grillo Terre Siciliane Family and Friends 2022 (Italy)

Grillo is minerally, spice white from Sicily with bright acidity and freshness.

Rippon Riesling Central Otago Lolo's 2019 (New Zealand)

Only made once, this single vineyard dry riesling is a treat to taste.

Joh. Jos Prum Riesling Mosel Wehlener Sonnenuhr Kabinett 2019 (Germany)

A crisp and elegant Riesling that embodies the mineral-rich slate soils of the Mosel.

Müller-Catoir Riesling Pfalz Mussback Kabinett 2021 (Germany)

An expressive and harmonious Riesling from renowned family-run estate.

Hillick & Hobbs Riesling Seneca Lake Estate Vineyard Dry 2020 (New York)

Winemaker Paul Hobbs also makes this great dry riesling in New York state.

Rose

Graci Etna Rosato 2021 (Italy)

This has all the volcanic influences of great reds from this fascinating region.

Raen Winery The Monarch Challenge Rose 2022 (California)

Special rosé from the Mondavi brothers to raise awareness of insect loss.

Red

Jean Foillard Morgon Cote du Py 2021 (France)

Master winemaker and vineyardist of Beaujolais and from old vines.

Ochota Barrels Grenache McLaren Vale Fugazi Vineyard 2021 (Australia)

Fresh and elegant grenache with lots of character from spices to meat.

Château Tour Saint Christophe St.-Emilion 2020

A robust Bordeaux blend with the depth and structure that St.-Emilion is renowned for.

Domaine Mee Godard Morgon Côte du Py 2020 (France)

Another fantastic Bojo from Korean-born winemaker that you need to know.

Sato Gamay Central Otago Le Ferme de Sato Alyssum 2020 (New Zealand)

Husband and wife team from Japan do everything themselves from vine to bottle. Great.

MEDIUM-BODIED AND CRUNCHY

Matias Riccitelli Chardonnay Gualtallary 2022 (Argentina)

A testament to the high-altitude terroir's potential from young and innovative winemaker.

René Bouvier Bourgogne Aligoté Vieilles Vignes 2018 (France)

An aligoté with body and character more like top Merusault.

Famille Hugel Riesling Alsace Estate 2019 (France)

Long-time JS favorite in dry, fruity riesling highlights the diverse soils of Alsace.

Mark Haisma Saint-Romain Blanc 2019 (France)

Australian winemaker making top wines in Burgundy, especially in lesser-known appellations.

Schäfer-Fröhlich Riesling Nahe Felseneck Kabinett 2021 (Germany)

A vibrant Riesling with lively acidity and a bouquet of citrus and stone fruits.

Brewer-Clifton Chardonnay Santa Rita Hills 2021 (California)

Cool climate chardy with minerally, crisp character from Greg Brewer.

Felton Road Chardonnay Central Otago Block 2 2021 (New Zealand) 1.5L

Old vine chardonnay from Wente Clone from benchmark wine producer. Body, soul.

Errázuriz Chardonnay Aconcagua Costa Las Pizarras 2020 (Chile)

Reference point in Chile for great chardonnay with complexity and polish.

Louis Latour Meursault 2020 (France)

Always outstanding Meursault that focuses on precision and purity.

An attractive New World Cabernet Franc from a highly regarded Mendoza winery.

Faustino Rioja Faustino I Gran Reserva 2011 (Spain)

A classic Rioja, aged gracefully, offering a complex array of dried fruits, leather, and spice.

La Valentina Montepulciano d'Abruzzo Terre dei Vestini Belovedere Riserva 2020 (Italy)

An intense and rich Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, with a palate of ripe red fruits, earthy notes.

Giusti Montello Superiore Tenuta Abazia Umberto I 2019 (Italy)

A bold and structured Italian red, showcasing the intensity of the Montello terroir.

K Vintners Syrah Yakima Valley Motor City Kitty 2019 (Washington)

Rich yet fresh syrah with lots of character and deliciousness.

Hyde de Villaine Napa Valley Hyde Vineyard Belle Cousine 2016 (California)

HdV (part owner Aubert de Villaine of DRC) makes superb Bordeaux blend in Carneros.

Masi Amarone della Valpolicella Classico Costasera 2018 (Italy)

A complex interplay of dried fruit, spice, and a hint of mocha, with a long, satisfying finish.

Tommasi Amarone della Valpolicella Classico 2018 (Italy)

Excellent example of new wave Amarone focusing on freshness, and balance.

Matias Riccitelli Malbec Cabernet Franc Mendoza Riccitelli & Father 2019 (Argentina)

Bold and complex red blend with vibrant fruit flavors and elegant spice notes.

Xiao Ling Cizhong Sentiers de Xiao Ling 霽岭之道 2019 (China)

Second wine of Xiao Ling is fresh, vivid cab and merlot blend. From Shangri-La.

Martin Ray Cabernet Sauvignon Napa Valley Diamond Mountain 2017 (California)

This is mountain cabernet with lovely perfumes and pretty finesse.

Montes Carmenere Petit Verdot Valle de Colchagua Purple Angel 2017 (Chile)

Cult wine from Chile with a fruit-forward nature and vivid energy.

Château Beychevelle St.-Julien 2018 (France)

Enjoy the upfront fruit of the 2018 vintage that's nicely framed with firm tannins.

Château Pontet-Canet Pauillac 2005 (France)

This is a favorite vintage of JS, and Pontet-Canet delivers from its bio-dynamic vineyards.

SWEET

Carnes de Rieussec Sauternes 2017 (France) 375ml

Second wine of Rieussec offers sweetness and brightness in a young vintage.

Donnafugata Passito di Pantelleria Ben Ryé 2019 (Italy)

Rich, sweet dessert wine from sun-dried raisins on a tiny island in southern Italy.

Dow's Port 20 Years Old Tawny NV (Portugal)

Dried fruits, toffee, and wood tones make this aged tawny sweet joy.

Sauska Tokaji Aszú 5 Puttonyos 2017 (Hungary) 500ml

Brilliant sweet Tokaji from one of the top names in Hungary.
